(COVID 19 PREPAREDNESS PLAN – NORTHLAND HOCKEY GROUP TOURNAMENTS)

Spacing:

There is plenty of room in our arena bleachers to maintain social distancing. We will stagger resurfacing to avoid congestion in lobby areas and if weather permits, wait outside and enjoy the weather while waiting for your son or daughter to leave the rink. Resurfacing will be done at the conclusion of game only (not every two periods) to help keep games on time and avoid possible overlap.

Kindness:

Respect the space of others and keep your distance while in common areas such as lobby's, bathrooms and concession area. **Masks are mandatory for all players, coaches, officials and spectators.** If you cough or sneeze please do so in your bent elbow portion of your arm. Wash your hands for 20 seconds with soap and water.

Accountability:

Everyone needs to be responsible for his or her actions. If you are sick or not feeling well, even with mild symptoms, STAY HOME. We are also asking siblings to stay home if possible.

Teamwork:

We will eliminate the post-game hand-shake. Goals/Victories should be celebrated individually; no team celebration/hugs/piling on. Plyers should come dressed prior to the game and limit time in locker rooms. Leave bags in your car. Players are to leave their gloves on at all times once dressed. Please bring your OWN water bottle and fill prior to entering arena.

Entrance: Players are allowed in the rink 10 minutes prior to game time, goalies 15 minutes. Spectators are allowed in at game time. Only two parents allowed in per skater, siblings only if necessary. Please leave the rink immediately following the game and do not wait in lobby area.
